About six months ago we reported on an overcrowded parking situation on McCaan Drive and Thrushwood. The building that housed a skating rink on that street had been purchased and coverted into a roller derby. The response to the roller derby was great and the 600+ attendees could not be accommodated by the 200 parking spots. Our neighborhood served the overflow.

Roger Wines, our president, was working with the owner, Pete Moran, and the police and fire departments on a resolution to the parking overflow. Mr. Moran was incredibly understanding and cooperative. For the next 2 derby events he made provision for additional parking, and utilizing a couple people and signs, had the overflow park in another area. The improvement was significant. He has called Roger after every event to ensure that the solution continues to be effective.

We want to thank Mr. Moran, for all his efforts in going the extra mile to find a solution. The neighbors we have spoken with have noticed a difference and are extrememly pleased. Thank you so much!!



Neighborhoods throughout Austin are being invited to join with thousands of communities nationwide to participate in the 20th Annual 'National Night Out'. APD officers, firefighters and City Council Members will attend neighborhood parties throughout Austin and participate in a neighborhood walk.

'National Night Out' is an opportunity to:

- Heighten awareness of drug and crime prevention efforts
- Generate support and participation in crime prevention efforts
- Strengthen neighborhood spirit and police community relations
- Send a message to criminals to let them know that neighborhoods are organized and fighting back

For the past eight years, Texas had led the nation in citizen and police involvement. Your participation in the Austin area 'National Night Out' will show neighborhood strength, increase the police officer/citizen bond and make our community a safer place to live.

Who is going to get the party started on your block / street?

Hosting a party simply means that you are offering your front yard/driveway as a gathering place for your neighbors to meet each other. This is a great time to get to know your neighbors and maybe exchange address and phone information in case of emergencies.
