

Minutes of the NSCNA

The annual meeting of the NSCNA was held in the Pillow Elementary School Cafetorium on February 23, 1987 at 7:15 P.M.

The meeting was called to order by Pres. Pat Sullivan. The minutes of the January, 1986 meeting were not read. Treasurer Harold Anderson reported a balance of \$302.74.

President Dudley Smith then presided. Membership of \$15.00 in the Austin Neighborhoods Council was voted on and passed. A donation of a book to the Pillow Library by the Association was voted on and passed.

Chip Harris from Crestview Neighborhood Association announced that his association is sponsoring a candidates' forum for the city council election at St. Louis' Catholic Church.

Mike Poer from the City of Austin Planning and Growth Management Department was the guest speaker. The topic was the Austinplan process and goals. Chip Harris added commentary about the Austin Roadway Plan and the future of Steck Avenue.

The cash drawing was held.

The meeting was adjourned by President Dudley Smith.
