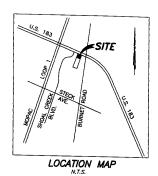

- NOTES:

  1. No lot in this subdivision shall be accupied until connected to the City of Austin Water and Wastewater System. All water and wastewater system improvements must be in accordance with City of Austin Water and Wastewater System Design Criteria and Specifications. All water and wastewater plans must be approval. All water of Austin Water and Wastewater Utility for review and city of Austin Water and Wastewater Utility for review and city of Austin.
- 2. Building setback lines shall be in conformance with City of Austin zoning ordinance requirements.
- No buildings, fences landscaping or other structures which obstruct flow are permitted in drainage easements except as approved by the City of Austin.
- All drainage easements on private property shall be maintained by the property owner or his assigns.
- Property owner shall provide for access to drainage easements as may be necessary and shall not prohibit access by governmental authorities.
- The electric utility has the right to prune and/or remove trees, shrubbery and other obstructions to the extent necessary to keep casements clear. The utility will perform all tree work in compliance with Chapter 13–7, Article II of the City of Austin Land Development Code.
- The owner/developer of this subdivision/jot shall provide the City of Austin Electric Utility Deportment with any easement and/or access required, in addition to those indicated, for the installation and angiong maintenance of overhead and underground electric facilities. These easements and/or access are required to provide electric service to the building, and will be accessed to the state of the case the sits to be out of compliance with Chapter 13—7 of the City of Austin Land Development Code.
- The owner shall be responsible for installation of temporary erosion control, revegetation and tree protection for Electric Utility work required to provide electric service to this project.
- A public sidewalk built to City of Austin standards is required along the subdivision side of U.S. 183 as shown on the face of the Plat. This sidewalk shall be in place prior to the lot being occupied. Failure to construct the required sidewalk may result in the withholding of Certificates of Occupancy, Building Permits or Utility Connections by the governing body or utility company.
- This subdivision is located in the Shool Creek Watershed, classified as Urban. All development shall be constructed and maintained in accorda with the terms and conditions of Chapter 13-7, Article I of the City of Austin Land Development Code.
  - a. Erosion and Sedimentation controls are required to be installed prior to construction, pursuant to LDC Section 13-7-14. Erosion and sedimentation controls ore also required for all construction on each lot including single family and duplex construction pursuant to LDC Section 13-7-14.
  - All slopes in this subdivision are less than 15% and the entire subdivision is located within the Uplands Zone as defined by ordinance.
  - c. For a minimum travel distance of twenty five feet from the roodway edge, driveway grades may exceed 14% only with the specific written approval of the surface and geometric design proposals by the Transportation and Public Works Department and the Department of Planning and Development of the City of Austin.
- 11. Prior to constuction on any lot in this subdivision, except for residential houses, a site development permit must be obtained from the City of Austin.
- 12. All signs shall comply with the Austin Sign Ordinance, Chapter 13—2 Article VII.
- 13. Lots 49, 50, 51 & 52, Block "A", shall utilize a joint use driveway for access to U.S. 183
- No alike development permit may be granted nor improvements of any kind may be constructed on any lot in this subdivision until offsite drainage, detention and water quality improvements are completed and accepted by the City of Austin.
- 15. Prior to construction on lots in this subdivision, drainage plans will be submitted to City of Austin for review. Fainfull run-off shall be held to the amount existing at undeveloped status by pending or other approved methods.
- 16. The owner of this subdivision and his or her successors and osigns, assumes responsibility for plans for construction of subdivision improvements which comply with applicable codes and requirements of the City of Austin. The owner understands and ocknowledges that paid vacation or repetiting may be required, at the owners sole expense, if plans to construct this subdivision do not comply with such codes and requirements.
- 17. This subdivision was approved and recorded prior to the construction and acceptance of all streets and other subdivision improvements. Pursuant to the terms of a Subdivision improvement Agreement between the subdivider and the subdivider are separable for all improvement needed to serve the lots within this subdivision. This responsibility may be assigned in accordance with the terms of that agreement. For the Subdivision improvement Agreement pertaining to this subdivision, see separate instrument recorded in Volume 12.942 Page 16.3 of the Real Property Records of Travis County, Texas.
- 18. Development in this subdivision is restricted to uses other than single family/duplex residential.
