President's Column: It's Election Time



City of Austin elections will be held on Saturday, May 14, the same day as our Neighborhood Yard/Garage Sale.

When you go to the polls you'll get to cast four votes: one vote apiece for each of three City Council races, and one vote for our neighborhood.

That's because the higher our turnout, the more important our neighborhood becomes to City Hall. So please cast your vote and support North Shoal Creek.

Here are some turnout figures for the last couple of City Council elections:

Year	Precinct 252	City-wide
2009	514 (19.9%)	58,610 (13.1%)
2008	385 (14.5%)	35,858 (8.3%)

As you can see, our neighborhood (Precinct 252) traditionally turns out strongly in local elections. Let's see if we can top 20% turnout this year.

Early voting will take place May 2 - May 10. If you are a registered voter, you may vote at any early voting location.

The location closest to us will be Ben Hur Shriners Hall at 7811 Rockwood Ln. On the day of the election, you'll need to vote at our assigned precinct location, Pillow Elementary School.

While you are there, be sure to thank the election judges who staff the polling place. Many are neighbors and NSCNA members. Their work supports our neighborhood and our democracy.
