City Watering Rules in Effect

In June, the City of Austin issued Stage 1 Watering Restrictions for Austin residents. What does this mean for us (and our yards and gardens)?

- If you're using an irrigation system or sprinklers, you can water your lawn twice a week. If your address ends in an odd number, you can water on Wednesdays and Saturdays. If it ends in an even number, you can water on Thursdays and Sundays.
- On your assigned day, you can use your irrigation system or sprinklers *only* before 10 am or after 7 pm.
- You can water by hand with a hose at any time.
- Businesses and multi-family homes follow the same restrictions, but their watering days are Tuesdays and Fridays.



If you notice any watering that does not follow these guidelines, you can call 311 to report it to the city. Violations are misdemeanors and violators can be fined up to \$500.
