Tom Ney volunteered to be the single point of contact between the Neighborhood Association and the City regarding the cleanup and maintenance issues.

Julie Blankenship was presented as the next speaker. Julie represents a local martial arts school, and reviewed the basics of self defense and how to buy and use a mace defense tool.
