GUEST SPEAKER HIGHLIGHTS:

Dale Cooper, an officer with the Austin Police Department for twelve years, spoke to the group about safety and security issues of interest to neighborhood residents, and distributed Resource Packets to the group. Officer Cooper answered many questions from the group. There was strong interest in the subject of Neighborhood Watch. He recommended that individual residents should talk to their immediate neighbors to begin the process of beginning a Neighborhood Watch.

OLD BUSINESS:

SPEED BUMPS:

Dallas gave a review of the events concerning the neighborhood's desire to have speed bumps, and the City of Austin's past and current position on speed bumps. New construction is currently on hold by the City. A meeting scheduled for May 7th in the City Council Assembly Room was recommended to anyone interested. The group was divided over the speed bump issue, and other alternatives were discussed.

The Zoning Committee continues to negotiate with the owner, who has agreed to conditional overlays for the property.

LUCAS TRACT: (South on 183)

There will be no automotive sales business permitted in the property facing 183.

NEW BUSINESS:

BURNET & STECK (SE Corner):

Members of the Zoning Committee will meet on the 19th of this month with attorneys who represent a group interested in purchasing developing the tract.

PILLOW PTA REQUEST:

The Pillow PTA is preparing a petition to the Area Superintendent for AISD, recommending that students leaving Pillow 5th grade be sent to Murchasin Middle School . The PTA is requesting the Associations support.
