Discussion Items:

1. Buell Noise Concerns: Noise caused, apparently at Winn Meat Co, 2620 Buell, in early morning hours (2:30 to 3:00 a.m.) Dallas Maham will open dialogue with Winn Co.

Trucks parking illegally while drivers are at Branner. Jeff Russell will talk with Branner.

2. Roadway stripping concerns discussed:

Crosscreek has no stripping. We would like to know why. Dallas will attempt to solve.

At all stop signs a white pavement marking is used to designate place to stop. At number of stop signs don't have this mark. We will inventory all stop signs not marked. Rockwood has (inconsistent) lane markings. We will investigate why.

3. Sidewalks:

There are many sidewalks in need of repair. Keith Harrell will inventory.

A number of streets have no sidewalks. Discussion was held on possibly surveying residents of such streets. We will discuss possible action at a later date.

4. Permanent Flashing Speed Indicators were discussed.

There are a number of questions such as: Does City of Austin have guide lines regarding these speed indicators? What is the coat? Who installs them? When these and other questions are answered the committee will consider recommending these signs.

5. Also discussed were the reflective markings at fire hydrants. Keith Harrell will check all neighborhood hydrants, for reflectors, and report back.
